

WERE NORTH CAROLINA & SOUTH CAROLINA FORMERLY ONE STATE?

No, they were not one State. NC and SC were 2 of the original 13 colonies whose delegates signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. SC was the 2nd and NC was the 10th Colony to ratify the Articles of Confederation in 1778. A decade later it was replaced by the US Constitution, with SC being the 8th State (5/23/1788) and NC being the 12th State (11/21/1789) to ratify it.




13 STATES IN 1783 REVOLUTIONARY WAR VICTORY! TREATY OF PARIS

WERE NORTH CAROLINA & SOUTH CAROLINA FORMERLY ONE COLONY?

(The following discussion does not include the English Lost Colony of Roanoke of 1585-89 in present-day NC; nor the French Charlesfort of 1562-63 which became the Spanish outpost Santa Elena of 1566-1587, in present-day SC.)

Carolina: a vast proprietary province.

The First and only permanent English settlement was in **1655** in the Albemarle Sound area (now Northeast NC) by VA colony trader Nathaniel Batts and some farmers who were now free from indenture in VA, who began small farms. They enjoyed privacy and independence in their rural community. They were settled there already in 1663/ 1665 when King Charles II "gave" their portion and this entire vast territory "Carolina" to **8** "Lords Proprietor" in England. Down the Pamlico river, NC's FIRST town - Bath - was established in 1705. By 1708 it had grown to 12 houses and 50 people.



The Charter of Carolina 1663

The English Proprietors initiated *their* **First** settlement 7 years later in 1670 - Charles Town, named for the King, to become a great port city and base of expansion of settlements. It wasn't a "second" to the rural farm community of Albemarle settlement; it was something different - the first planned city in the region. Charlestown (now Charleston SC) was settled first by 150 English colonists from Barbados who soon brought enslaved people to produce indigo and rice on plantations. It grew quickly to become significantly wealthy, and the leading city of the South. More English colonists and other Europeans soon began to populate Charleston and surrounding areas.

WERE NC AND SC EVER ONE COLONY?

Because the Carolina Province was a vast area that today includes 6 US states, this question is somewhat ambiguous.

Why "ambiguous": "Carolina" was not a territory that was split into the combined land today known as the states of North Carolina and South Carolina. In other words, If NC and SC came together today as one state, it would not restore the boundaries of the land tract that the Proprietary Carolina Colony was. It would take 6 states, plus or minus some border acreage, to restore the original Carolina. It could also be said it would take 13 states plus some of Mexico!

For ~49 years, 1663-1712, while it was largely yet unexplored, it was one vast area per the Carolina Charter, at first extending to the Pacific Ocean, then only to the Mississippi River. As settlements formed, the separate territorial identities of North Carolina and South Carolina became apparent and official. So in 1712 a governor was appointed for North Carolina Colony (presently NC and TN) and another for South Carolina Colony (presently SC, GA, AL, MS). In 1729 the King bought the land back, and they became 2 Royal Colonies. Then 3 years later in 1732 they became 3 Colonies. (Continued on next page.)



WERE NC AND SC EVER ONE COLONY?

So, at the time of the American Revolution there were <u>3 Colonies</u> that had formerly been the combined area of Carolina Colony.

In 1732, Georgia Colony (presently GA, AL, MS) was carved out of South Carolina Colony.

In subsequent years NC ceded its western territory which became TN, and GA ceded its western territory which became AL and MS.

So, technically all or significant portions of 6 US States are in the land area once chartered under the name "Carolina."



WERE NC AND SC ONE COLONY?

Timing:

At the Revolution in 1776 North Carolina and South Carolina were two of the 13 American Colonies, not one Carolina.

Prior to becoming 2 Royal Colonies (owned by King of England) in 1729, they were 2 Proprietary Colonies (owned by 8 Proprietors) stretching from the Atlantic to the Mississippi, between Virginia and Florida.

Prior to becoming 2 Proprietary Colonies in 1712, they were one Province called Carolina, largely unexplored, chartered in 1663. (For a time Carolina was claimed by the King of England to extend to the Pacific Ocean.)

So for ~49 years there was one Carolina Colony, granted to political/ merchant friends of the King (8 Lords Proprietor) for their assistance, in 1663, with the understanding that they would settle it. Two years later in 1665 the King extended the land to include the first (unplanned) settlement, Albemarle (farm community established by settlers from VA), just south of the Chesapeake.

HISTORIAN VIEWPOINTS ON THE 3 COLONIES THAT EMERGED FROM CAROLINA PROVINCE

SC: The southern part of "Carolina" served first as support for the British West Indies. Soon the slave economy of the sugar islands reached the shores of Carolina. The cultivation of rice in the plantation system quickly became profitable, and planters in the hundreds and slaves in the tens of thousands soon inhabited Carolina. At the heart of the colony was the merchant port of Charles Town. African slaves became a majority of the population in SC before the middle of the eighteenth century.

NC: By contrast, the earliest inhabitants of the northern part were displaced former indentured servants from the Chesapeake in VA. Most established small tobacco farms. Slavery existed, but in far smaller numbers than in the neighboring regions. The inhabitants felt as though the aristocrats from Virginia and the Charles Town area looked down their noses on them. Northern Carolina, like Rhode Island in the North, drew the region's discontented masses. http://www.ushistory.org/us/5c.asp It was widely regarded that South Carolina culture had more in common with Virginia than it did with North Carolina. "North Carolina's nickname for many years was 'a vale of humility between two mountains of conceit'; the 'mountains' were Virginia and South Carolina."

GA: James Oglethorpe had a charitable vision for a Colony, including debtors getting out of prison to do productive work as settlers, etc. His team established the first GA settlers on the coast in 1732. Prior, this unsettled land was part of the vast Carolina tract. So Georgia Colony was carved out of South Carolina - a little noted fact.
