Susie: Each month we gather to celebrate the Lord on behalf of our families, Troop, and our land. He's FIRST! We thank the Lord for His blessing when we bring an offering of our hearts at First Fruits. Lord, we not only ask You to bless us, but bless our territory as we gather. We seek You, Holy Spirit, for Your

revelation for us this month. *1 Timothy 1:5 The goal of our instruction is LOVE from a pure heart, a good conscience, and a sincere faith.*

Iyar is a month to grow in Wisdom and Discernment for thriving in Kingdom life and ministry. Our verse this month is **Proverbs 8:34-35 TPT** *"If you wait at wisdom's doorway, longing to hear a word for every day, joy will break forth within you as you listen for what I'll say. For the fountain of life pours into you every time that you find me, and this is the secret of growing in the delight and the favor of the Lord."*

Finishing Nisan Well: Testimony - See Jesus, See the Real Move of God (Kim)

Kim: Jennie Wrenn had shared about the false sickle structure reaping in the harvest field. The show American Idol is very secular but this year was the first time they had the contestants choose a worship song. Everyone was responding by hands raised. I saw there is a move of God, **a TRUE voice speaking the glory of God, BUT there is also a fake move trying to look like the TRUE move of God.** Those veiled ones are hearing and seeing a move but they do not have the Spirit of Truth. It is bewitching them! There is a move of God changing the atmosphere and people are responding to Holy Spirit. But the enemy is going to mimic anything God is doing. It is very popular right now to hear worship music, and people are responding, but I can see that fake move, that fake sickle is trying to mimic what God is doing, and to harvest those souls that Jennie saw. **We need discernment!**

Acts 9:3-5 *"As he journeyed, he came near Damascus and suddenly a light shone on him from heaven. Then he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?' And he said 'Who are you Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus.'"*

This is my prayer, Lord, in this month of Iyar that is linked to light and revelation, that those that are being veiled, that suddenly a light comes and they see Jesus, and they respond to the true move of the Holy Spirit! Father, we ask that they would get right and it would take them into their Pentecost moment, and they'd be filled, and a become a laborer of truth in that service. Lord, I pray for our discernment this month and moving forward. Father, I pray for a deeper revelation of Your Word, a deeper revelation of what You're doing, and we can advance in this month in our prayers and watches. We surrender to You, Father, for a new level of discernment. We thank You for the level of discernment that we have, but we know there's more. We'll sit at the gate every day and ask for more discernment, that we can reap that harvest for Your Glory. **Spirit of Truth, please lead those that are veiled into Your truth and set them free, in Jesus' Name, to SEE HIM, Know the Truth, and recognize the true move of God!**

Susie: Lord, I pray our hearts would be pure: 1 Timothy 1:5 - a demonstration of authentic worship that would rise up in the harvest field above a fake worship, to draw people. Lord, You said when You are lifted up, You will draw all unto You. We pray our worship will be authentic and magnify Your name in our atmosphere.

All: Lord, we are all here to worship You! We together are Your people; You alone are our God!

Revelatory Insight for Iyar (Jennie)

Susie: We want to hear and see the illumination and revelation that the Lord is giving us for this month so that we can accurately interpret and apply, activate and mobilize in this all month long. The Hebrew letter for the month of Iyar is the Vav, and that is the connector. So Iyar typically is called the Connector Month.

I'm seeing something a little differently this year: in these 50 days between Passover and Pentecost **I see a series of doors for us to very carefully transition through with the Lord to get to the end. We want to move with Him through every door in His timing.** 1 Corinthians 16 - an open door for effectual ministry, and there are many that oppose. That's the picture of our transition this year - not just one month to the next, but a series of transitions that the Lord is bringing us to move into triumph. I want to reiterate, the Lord is going to give us everything we need to get through these doors and get past the opposition, but we have to take it one step at a time with Him.

This is a month for transition and hope-filled anticipation in the Word and Will of God, gaining strategies for mission success!

Jennie: Genesis 49:14-15 (TPT) *"Issachar is a strong donkey lying down between its saddle bags. When he sees that his resting place is good, and his portion is so pleasant, then he will bend his shoulder to the burden and labor for his master."*

It says that burdens must be carried, but carried within the pleasant land of resting in God's sweet presence. We must bow our shoulders to the burden of the Lord. God has a burden to share, but He wants for intercessors to find the resting place and bow their shoulder to His burden. True sons of Issachar will submit voluntarily to prayer. But it's a pleasant place, it's a resting place.

Revelatory Insight for Iyar, cont'd

1. Undue Burdens. The Lord has shown me that shoulders have been weakened by undue burdens. It's things, it's assignments, it's prayer assignments, it's burdens that we've been carrying that are not ours. Maybe there are even things that were ours to carry but the season's over. It's things that are on our shoulders that aren't meant to be on our shoulders, and now they've weakened them. Those undue burdens need to come off and we need our shoulders strengthened. Psalm 18:32 talks about being clothed in strength. We need to really be clothed in strength and our shoulders ready, ready to bow down, and bow into what it is He has for us.

Susie: That resonates! Identify any undue burden that you've carried, leave those behind. This so connects with discernment. The Lord is putting us in a higher place now, and we must discern when it's the burden He wants us to pick up and discern when it's the burden He doesn't want us to pick up.

Lord, we thank You for identifying and shining Your light on this. Lord, give us discernment and give us alertness. Give us a wisdom and a knowing. Lord, I pray we will be more effective in our intercession even as we only share the burdens that You want us to share with You. We recognize this is a critical time; our intercession means something. And Lord, we want to be at the right place at the right time, praying the right thing You've given us to pray.

Jennie: Issachar - they know the times and seasons. *Kairos* really stands out because it's right place right time.

2. It is a critical time to be on post. I had a dream. I was called to a very specific post, but doubt came. I gave way to doubt, which led me to give way to specific distractions which kept me from being on my post. By the time I got back, I could tell it was really bad that I'd not been on my post.

1) The distractions were familiar, and they were things that I had been delivered from and overcome. But He showed me almost like specks of yeast, and under the right circumstance, those things just blew up. It took over the whole lump and it created a big, big distraction and something that I wouldn't even think would be an issue. That distraction really got me off my post. Although I came back to the post, I then realized it was really bad that I'd gotten distracted, starting with the doubt.

2) I was at my call to my post because He called me to my post. So everything else was irrelevant doubts. I needed to be on my post because it was a critical time.

That was the main thing - the seriousness of the assignment. It was a *Body of Christ as an Ekklesia* time, it was an intercession time. And what was required was to stay there and not let anything else come in.

I felt like it was a real wake up call from the Lord about being aware about distractions, or what could even lead you to the distraction. Because being on post and knowing the time and season is so key.

Susie: ON POST. We know what it's like to be given an assignment from the Lord. In Jennie's dream, this was an assignment in which she had to persevere. And there were all kinds of reasons in the dream that took her away from the one thing that the Lord is asking her to do. That speck of yeast really connects with our Scripture from Nisan about Passover and getting the leaven out, getting the mixture out. Getting off post - when we start looking at ourselves, evaluating whether we're doing enough or whether we're good enough for the assignment - in Jennie's dream, that was a real quick way that she got off the post by looking at herself. **Jennie:** The Lord showed me that was a door for the distractions. Those things were like the door creaking open. And at that point, I couldn't stop myself. That was the thing that opened the door for distractions. **Susie:** The doors that we'll have to go through, they are training. The Lord is going to teach us things as we go through these transitional doors during this next 50 days.

Jennie: 3. Wisdom. Proverbs: 7:4 (TPT) *"Say to wisdom, I love you, and to understanding, you're my sweetheart."* That's been a daily declaration and almost become like a cheer with my kids or with whoever's here: *"Say to wisdom, I love you,"* and they'll shout back, *"to understanding, you're my sweetheart!"* There's something about that - like you're being bolstered with them. *"Wisdom, I love you, and understanding you're my sweetheart."* There's something about that declaration, and really saying that - getting us through. So it's wisdom and understanding and moving forward - not human understanding - divine understanding is key. The Lord burns my heart with Proverbs 8:34, *"If you wait at wisdom's doorway, longing to hear a word for every day, joy will break forth as you listen for what I'll say."* I wake up and I can't take a step, can't go any further. I'm at wisdom's doorway, and without fail, every day it comes through. It brings such joy. I feel like it's such a key for this month. And it talks about it being the guard to guard the door of my entrances. So wisdom guards the door of entrances, speaking of doors.

Revelation Responses

Susie: I love the word "wait" in there - when we wait at wisdom's doorway. *Every day and waiting.* There's a faithfulness that is day by day that is not the same as routine. When it becomes routine, it's time to change the way that you do it, yet do it daily. I encourage y'all to memorize Prov 8:34 TPT. As we are going day by day to Pentecost, every day is important. Getting wisdom from the Lord at every doorway is key.

Nancy: Psalm 68:19 *"What a glorious God! He gives us salvation over and over and daily He carries our burdens."*

Matthew: (re burdens - Jennie) Decree for Troop: By the word of the Lord, my God and Father, I decree and declare that my emotions, thoughts, actions, attitude, mindset, and words are under the control of my beautiful, beloved Holy Spirit, because I have submitted them to Him, in Jesus' name! And I have that set on my phone for three strategic times throughout the day because that right circumstance can come, so we have to be prepared and not off guard.

The Lord gave me a specific ratio of how much time to spend with Him during the summer so that I can walk forward in the post and the assignment. I decree that we will step fully into the ratio that God Himself has already balanced perfectly for each and every one of us, spending the right amount of time in the right way, for the right reasons with the Lord, so that we are fully equipped to walk out the assignment, in Jesus' name.

Susie: ... the importance of us declaring faith and declaring the path, declaring agreement with the Lord. Not only how much time we spend with Him, but that we are communing and communicating with the Lord throughout our day, being able to hear Him, hear that still, small voice saying, "This is the way, walk in it."

Camille: Isaiah 52:1 *"Awake! Awake, Zion, clothe yourself with strength. Put on your garments of splendor, Jerusalem, the Holy city, the uncircumcised and defiled will not enter you again. Shake off your dust. Rise up, sit, enthroned Jerusalem, free yourself from the chains on your neck daughter Zion, now a captive, for this is what the Lord says, 'You were sold for nothing, and without money you will be redeemed.'"* It resounds because Thursday morning I woke up, and the Holy Spirit immediately said, "I want you to pay attention to what I am saying." It was very clear He was speaking to the Body, "Don't focus on your routine, focus on Me. Don't follow a routine. Follow Me!" He said, "Come up to Me, I have the answer. Follow Me, not your routine. Inquire of Me, and don't answer from your own knowledge and mind. Watch Me, and I will show you what to do."

Janelle: The cloud by day, the fire by night, and how they tarried or stayed one day, two weeks, whatever - they had to remain sensitive to that, so they could never develop a routine or be familiar. I feel Holy Spirit is speaking: Don't settle into routine. I'm going to change it up - one day or one week might be different from another. Don't settle into the routine because the enemy wants to lure us in, and then lull into numbness and familiarity. We can get into the motions of the driving, the assignment, and loose sight of God's ebb and flow and pause, or hearing Him saying to stand. There's this pressing and this pausing to be able to remain sensitive. **Susie:** And, we need to discern the difference between routine and discipline. We all need to find our discipline without it becoming routinized. Discipline is a good thing. Being routinized, the light goes out.

Tony: I heard it's a critical time to be on post like battle stations. "Ask, what's your post?" Without wisdom and understanding, we really won't know where to move in the battle. The alert is going out to seek for wisdom, your daily orders from the Holy Spirit of where you're supposed to move, where your feet stay. God takes you every day to your assignment. Stay on track. We need the daily wisdom to know what's coming our way, and the daily understanding to move in the revelation that comes our way.

Colleen: I had a dream in 2019 - I was in the city, and suddenly it looked like a WW2 scene where planes were dropping bombs and I'm in the midst of it. I was terrified, and turned to run, and the Lord said, "Stand where you are!" It was audible in my dream. I just wanted to flee but the instruction of the Lord was polar opposite to my instincts. We have to recognize we're in a season, and entering into a season where things are happening in the spirit that are going to make us want to abandon post. We have to hear the Lord's voice tell us when to move, how to move. It's going to ensure not just our safety physically, but it's also going to help us secure our gates for the future.

And I say we are those who hear Him say, "This is the way, walk in it," and we are in time with Him. We are all here at First Fruits, because we are understanding how to position ourselves in time with Him. It's a practice. God is positioning us in time; we're seeking Him diligently. We will hear Him!

And this Scripture from Bible Challenge - Deuteronomy is going over Law! Law! Law! "Do this, do that! Don't do this! Don't do that! If you do, you get stoned. If you do this, you get hung on a tree." I'm saying in my own soul, "This is heavy. Who can do this?" And then Deuteronomy 30:11 *"For this commandment which I command you today is not too difficult for you. Nor is it out of reach. It is not in heaven that you should say, 'Who will go up to heaven for us, and make us hear it, that we may observe it. Nor is it beyond the sea that you should say, 'Who will cross the sea for us to get it for us and make us hear it that we may observe it.' But the word is very near you in your mouth, and in your heart, that you may observe it."*

Anne: I praise God for what is happening here, as in *Hebrews 10:24-26* "Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Not giving up meeting together as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another. And all the more as you see the day approaching." Isn't it wonderful to have this place to come at the beginning of the month and encourage each other?! Thank you all for being here, and encouraging. During this gathering I've been sitting here praying. I know many of you are praying into this atmosphere, holding it open. I've been praying for God to open our eyes. I've been praying many things God's given me to pray, some to say, and some not. I trust that you are likewise. Some are giving a word of exhortation, some are singing a song, others are praying into an atmosphere that we all receive this. If you're hearing the voice of God as people are speaking, if Holy Spirit is whispering to your heart, someone here is carrying the right burden, like Issachar in a pleasant place, holding this atmosphere so that we actually hear Holy Spirit. Are we full of faith that God wants to activate us higher into hearing His voice? He's unveiling His mysteries to us, and He's giving us wisdom which can be very practical. If we move in it, He'll give us more.

Anne: We're going new and higher! Last month was the First of the twelve month new season, and here's what God gave us: "I carried you on eagle's wings and brought you to myself."

Way up out of whatever we've been in, as good as it has been, there's a higher place for us to go. Do y'all believe that? (ALL: Yes!)

This month, we're on expedition through Iyar 5785. What do you see in this picture here for our month ahead, where we're all going.

Various answer: Bunch of people - multi-gifted team; clock (for timing with Issachar, they knew the Word and seasons); expectations on their faces; pensive intensity on man's face; backpack for carrying; mountains in background (He is surrounding His troop); multi-generational; all wearing various layers of clothing to prepare and for comfort (all together as one moving forward) outdoors not keeping it all inside. We want to go where the people are, not just trying to get them to come into our church buildings.

THE POWER OF THE EKKLESIA GROWING IN WISDOM AND DISCERNMENT FOR KINGDOM EXPLOITS

Anne: From Nisan, last month, we focused on ministry and prayer and every occasion God gives us to say "See Him!" It was like this supernatural breath that came, for us to say, "See Him." In Iyar, Jesus made many post-resurrection appearances. This is a great time for people to recognize Jesus is alive! And let's all say this together, "May what began in Nisan go into fullness in Iyar!" We're not finished with that assignment to say to someone who has blinders, "See the Lord," and suddenly they can see Him.

We are doing the 50 Day Bible Challenge, cultivating hearing His voice in the Word, in worship, and in prayer. If you go on a ministry assignment with a multi-gifted team, you need to rely on the Voice of the Holy Spirit, do you not?

Now SEE HIM! See Him! When I say that, I want you to ask this question in your heart, did you receive it like, "I need to see the Lord" or did you receive it like, "I need to minister to others that they can see Him"? Ponder that in your heart and let the Lord tell you where you are on that. It's ok if you're going through something and it's hard to see Him. It's ok! Growing in the Lord higher He wants to use you as a minister of "See Him." So see Him and also see yourself ministering "See Him." Here's a way people saw Jesus, you see that in Acts 1. He presented Himself. It often happened when people were breaking bread with Jesus right? All of a sudden people saw Him when they were breaking bread with Him.

Seeing JESUS!

Acts 1:3-11 After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God. On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

... But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Why don't we do that? Just be like Jesus - break bread with people and they can see Him? Are we willing to be ministers for the Lord? In the situations where people need to see You, Lord, will You pull back the curtain and present Yourself?

Kim: Whenever I see Him, it's like when you're seeing something and you're pointing. I'm having others see Him, by saying "Look!" **Colleen:** And I say to them, "Don't do you see it too?" You know how He wants to reveal Himself to us right now. I think we need to stop being afraid to point to Jesus in the middle of what we're in. There's merit to seeing Jesus in the middle of where you are and pointing that to other people. There's a kairos witness of Jesus that we need to be unafraid of as the Ekklesia pointing to Jesus, where we see Him in this moment of encounter.

Anne: In Iyar He gave this promise, "Go wait to receive Holy Spirit for power." Iyar is a transition month. We're anticipating with great hopefulness. Look at those resurrection appearances, can you imagine seeing the resurrected Jesus? Amazing! **Camille:** I also like those resurrection appearance. He was a fish fryer. He was a doubt releaser. He was the Holy Spirit Giver! **Susie:** He was a teacher, word revealer. It's during this period of time that Jesus taught all the disciples that He encountered, especially the twelve, the prophecies that all point to Him.

Anne: I think about the ascension of Jesus so often - but not as often as the people who saw Him ascend did. I believe that every single day for the rest of their lives they looked up in the sky, wouldn't you? If you saw Jesus float upward, and some angels said, "Why do you stand here looking into the sky? The same Jesus who's been taken from you into heaven will come back in the same way you have seen Him go..." He got up out of the grave three days after they saw Him die. How soon do you think that they thought He was coming after He was floating up into the sky? Can you imagine living your life longing for His appearing in that kind of faith expectancy? What if we lived our lives longing for His appearing? How would we reorder our day? Look at the blessing that comes with longing for His appearing.

2 Tim 4:7-8

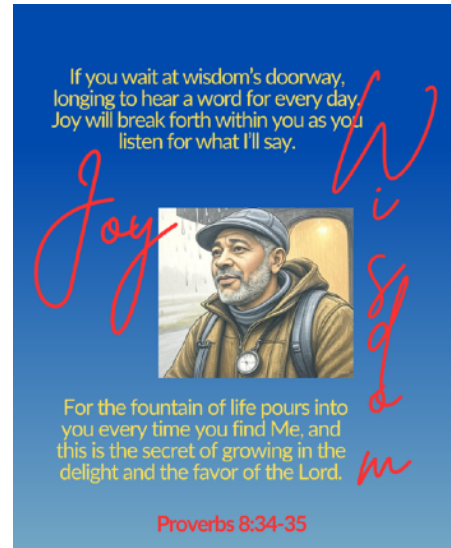
I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Holy Spirit wants to magnify Jesus, to reveal Him to people. I believe that if we long for the appearing of Jesus, and we live our lives around the Lord and His Word, and magnifying Jesus, we will find ourselves with angel-made appointments (Acts 10) saying, "See Jesus." And you know it could be that simple: "See Jesus." You don't have to memorize someone's plan of salvation, no. However Holy Spirit breathes, it can be two words, "See Jesus."

Wisdom, joy, the fountain of life - growing in the delight and favor of the Lord - does that sound good to you? These are promises for us this month. That same guy on the expedition, **what do you see in the picture here with** Proverbs 8:34-35?

Various answer: It's raining - that fountain of life pours into you (from above instead of up from the earth.) And he's got Joy on his face! Wisdom on his face! Look at that confidence. He can look at the days ahead like the Proverbs 31 woman does, and smile confidently and joyfully. Wh does she? And how may we look at those days ahead in this month? *Proverbs 8:34-35 "If you wait at wisdom's doorway, longing to hear a word for every day, Joy will break forth within you as you listen for what I'll say. For the fountain of life pours into you every time you find Me and this is the secret of growing in the delight and favor of the Lord."*

Anne: Amen! Why, why don't we? Why not? Let's go for it! *Semper Avanti*, always advancing! We decree that over this Troop. We're pulling that in every month as we're going higher and higher this year. From Nisan First, being lovers of the truth, exercising discernment - we get a double this month - press in during Iyar - it's a supernatural time for God to reveal His mysteries, His wisdom, and and what we need, to advance. **Susie:** In our discerning, what we're looking to discern is the voice of the Lord. We're looking to discern the presence of the Lord.



Matthew's Vision: Treasure Map

I had an amazing vision from the Lord and I believe it is for the Troop and significant as we enter Iyar. It super-charged me on the inside with amazing excitement and expectancy. A treasure map appeared and it was made of some type of cloth or leather. It was an old school map. The background of the map was beige. The Lord said He is planting moments in time for us to seek out and discover over these next nine months.



Susie: And plotted on that map are moments in time. What an Issachar picture! We don't want to miss our moments with the Lord; we want to find our moments with the Lord and fully execute on them. I believe what we've been talking about tonight is being equipped so that day by day we can be in communion and communication with the Lord, so that we will recognize when we have our moment - when we are at one of those plots on the map and we won't miss our moment. I believe that's the anointing of the Lord in wisdom and discernment that we've been talking about.

Anne: Consider that treasure map that Matthew saw and consider that picture of the team on the expedition. We've made a coloring page for the Lord and He's hanging it on His refrigerator to remember us all month.
